LIST OF MEASURED HERRING CARRIERS

The inclusion of the following list is a reminder of the wide ranged coastline industry with its' many packing company's and employees. History tells us that the Wm Underwood's factory, located in Jonesport, employed 250 people.

Following is a list of herring carriers, which have been measured to date in accordance with Chapter 325 of the Public Laws of 1949. Measurement has been made under the directions of the Commissioner of Agriculture and inquiries regarding this matter should be referred to Deputy State Sealer of Weights and Measures James A. Boyle, State House, Augusta, Maine.




